

INAUGURAL PARTIAL YEAR

2023 Inaugural Report

Establishing the journal and its publishing workflow

SJORANM began recording submissions in OJS in May 2023. This was therefore a partial inaugural year rather than a full calendar year. The priority was to establish the journal's editorial, technical and publishing workflows while releasing its first three issues.

Publication profile

The 2023 output comprised four reviews, three letters and communications, two case reports and one contribution in the Specials section. All ten published articles carry a DOI.

Assessment

The first publications created the journal's permanent scholarly record and showed that a Diamond Open Access model could be operated without submission or article processing charges. The low volume, geographically concentrated author base and incomplete structured capture of some editorial events are consistent with the start-up phase and provide a baseline for later reporting.

Priorities

- Stabilise OJS editorial and production workflows.
- Build a regular issue schedule and preserve DOI coverage.
- Improve structured author, affiliation, ORCID and editorial-event metadata.

Method and interpretation

This report uses the OJS Articles Report exported on 26 September 2026. Submissions are grouped by Date submitted and publications by First published. The figures describe calendar-year activity and are not cohort acceptance or conversion rates. Country totals reflect the metadata stored in OJS. Reliable annual reviewer and comparable usage statistics were not available and are therefore not inferred.

Institutional context

SJORANM GmbH is an independent Swiss limited liability company (GmbH), registered in Baar, Canton of Zug, Switzerland. It publishes and operates the Swiss Journal of Radiology and Nuclear Medicine. The journal is Diamond Open Access and charges neither submission nor article processing fees.
